General Terms for the Rental agreement deposit

- The credit balance, including interest, in favour of the Tenant booked on this rental deposit account is pledged in favour of the Landlord as security for all of the latter's claims against one and/or the other account holder arising out of the rental agreement between them.
- 2. Pursuant to the provisions of art. 257e CO, the Tenant and the Landlord can only dispose over the rental deposit account jointly or based on a legally valid order to pay or a legally valid court judgment.
- Upon the rental agreement having terminated and the Tenant having complied with all obligations arising therefrom, the Landlord is obliged to release the account balance in favour of the Tenant and to deliver to the latter the attached duly signed release declaration.
- 4. If the Landlord has not made a legal claim against the Tenant within one year after the termination of the rental agreement, the Tenant may request from the Bank, against presentation of evidence, the repayment of the account balance.
- 5. The Bank is entitled to provide information regarding the rental deposit account both to the Tenant and the Landlord at any time during the entire term of the rental deposit account.
- 6. For opening a rental deposit account, Zuger Kantonalbank charges an opening fee of CHF 30, regardless of the amount paid into the rental deposit account. The opening fee will not be levied if the Tenant has a ZugerKB account set (Young People, Start, Basic, Comfort, Premium) or a current account with Zuger Kantonalbank. Postage expenses incurred during the term of this agreement will be charged directly to the rental deposit account. If the rental deposit account is closed, the Bank is authorised to debit its account closing fees as per its price schedule to the rental deposit account in advance.
- 7. To have their account documents sent to them as e-banking documents, tenants must have e-banking access. If an e-banking contract already exists, the rental deposit account will be activated as per the tenant's instructions in the agreement. Where there is more than one tenant, or in the case of companies that do not have e-banking access, a new e-banking contract must be set up. In such cases the following applies:
 - a. Where there is more than one tenant, the e-banking contract will be opened under the name of Tenant 1 unless instructions to the contrary are stated in the agreement.
 - b. In the case of companies, the e-banking contract will be drawn up under the name of a private individual as per the instructions in the agreement. If the necessary information has not been provided in the agreement, it will be sent by post. Any amendments during the term of the present agreement must be communicated in writing and bear a legally binding signature (as per commercial register entry).
- 8. If no payment is made to the rental deposit account by the agreed date, the Bank has the right to close the rental deposit account after a period of 3 months without prior notice to the Tenant and the Landlord.
- 9. If any additional documents requested by the Bank are not submitted, the Bank may decide not to open a rental deposit account.
- 10. The current version of the General Terms and Conditions and the Conditions for the E-Banking Services of Zuger Kantonal-bank apply in all other respects. These can be found on the website of Zuger Kantonalbank at www.zugerkb.ch/base-documents. The Tenant and the Landlord acknowledge and agree to their contents.
